Paolo Patelmo's C.V. – Lawyer

BAR ADMISSION

Paolo is admitted - after 10 years passed as clerk of the court - to the Belluno Bar as attorney at Law (“avvocato”) since 1987. He is declared as lawyer having a secondary place of business also with the Venice, Rome, Florence and Pistoia Bar.

Allowed by the Court of Cassation (“abilitato al patrocinio avanti alle Giurisdizioni Superiori, Consiglio di Stato e Suprema Corte di Cassazione”).

CAREER

Born in “Palazzo Patelmo – Pollicarini” (a national listed building belonging to his family and shelter/summer residence of Viceroy of Sicily) in Enna on July 10, 1952 from a family of lawyers (from centuries) and nesters. Graduated in Law from the University of Catania, admitted to the Bar in 1987, admitted to practice before the Supreme Court in 1999.

In his adolescence, Paolo soon moved to Catania where he obtained (as in his long family tradition) a diploma in “classical studies” (“diploma di maturità classica”) and then a law degree (laurea in giurisprudenza) with a dissertation in criminal law. He lives in Venetian (where he moved to become a clerk of the court won the national public contest of the Ministry of Justice) from the 70's.

Completed the legal traineeship as trainee lawyer of Mrs Rita Mondolo law firm (lawyer at the Belluno Bar), he has passed, on the first try, the bar examination (license to practice law) in the District of Venice Court of Appeal.

Paolo has successfully attended the annual course “Specialized Training for criminal lawyer National School” (Corso della Scuola Nazionale di Formazione Specialistica per l'avvocato penalista) organised by the “Unione delle Camere Penali Italiane” in Rome reaching the qualification of lawyer specialized in criminal defense.

Paolo has achieved a university master degree in Sports Law at the “University of Social Studies Guido Carli” (LUISS) of Rome.

He is "mediator" (a.d.r. procedure) licensed by his belonging bar association.

After a significant experience as law teacher, and after having worked for 10 years as clerk of the court in Belluno, Paolo founded the eponymous law firm initially based in Belluno, then also with offices in Venice, Florence, Montecatini Terme and Rome.

Already lawyer in house for the district court of appeal of Venice of the major Italian social security institution, Paolo has created and directed (as outside counsel) for over a decade, the regional legal department for civil servants in the regional headquarters of the CISL Veneto, office who oversaw all the litigation, criminal and administrative civil servants in Triveneto. In particular, in his career he had the privilege to have witnessed tens of thousands of applicants (especially civil servants and trade unions), in litigation before administrative courts, both individual and collective, gaining a very significant experience at the national level of primary resonance.

Paolo has been member of the ministerial-union commission for the drafting of the disciplinary code of the Penitentiary Police: in this capacity, among other things, he has inspired the compulsoriness of the technical defence in disciplinary proceedings against the police officers in penitentiary police.

In criminal matter, Paolo has been involved as lawyer in delicate cases such of ones even of international resonance. Among these, in particular, he has witnessed, as general trusted lawyer for Italy, one of the largest insurers in the world, proceeded as legally liable, in criminal proceedings for the collapse of Tower A of the Court of Naples, imploded in following a mafia bomb.

With wide national echo he was involved in many cases of crime, such as mafia's attacks (in particular related to the criminal phenomenon of cd. "Mala del Brenta"), robberies, murders volunteers (including some who have been particularly eco media), kidnapping.

In the branch of civil and commercial law he stands out as trusted lawyer for Italy one of the largest corporations in the world in the production of safety systems. He has attended numerous cases of medical liability, both in civil litigation, both in criminal matters, on the whole national territory.

During his 30 years of career, Paolo's law firm has relied on the collaboration of highly skilled salary partners, many of them members or former member of the Bar Council, each of one highly specialised on a single law matter (such as, among others and considering the most important, Mr Giuseppe Triolo and Mrs Romina Zanvettor).

In each one of his law firm (in Belluno, Venice, Florence and Montecatini Terme) he relays on the collaboration of many salary partners specialized on a single law matter. In particular, from decades he trusts on the collaboration of Mrs Veronica Biagini (Florence Bar) his right-hand man and esteemed criminal lawyer, Mr Simone Zani (Florence Bar), Mr Luca Scalabrin (Labour consultant in Venice), Mr Antonio Ferrante (chartered accountant in Venice), Diego Longano (Milan Bar), Mr Lorenz Großrubatsher (ceo of the German desk), Mr Claudio Ronchietto, Mrs Lucrezia Raineri and Massimo Antonazzi.

Paolo has been a city councilman in his living town and a national politician in Italy and board member of his town territorial company for public housing.

He handles cases before the local Courts, before the Supreme Court and before national and

international arbitration panels.

He is regular speaker during conferences organised by the Bar and professional associations about white crime collars.

Paolo is knight of Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of Saint John of Jerusalem of Rhodes and of Malta (Sovereign Military Order of Malta).

Paolo is representative of “Camera di Commercio italiana negli EAU” (Italian industry & commerce office in the UAE).
